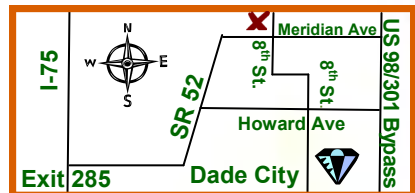
**5/10K WALK &

General Info: Join the Greater Dade City Chamber of Commerce and the Suncoast Sandpipers in a fun-filled, easy (rated 1B) 5K (3.1 mile) or 10K (6.2 mile) walk of historic Dade City and the Kumquat Festival. Walkers follow written directions, strolling on city streets and some unpaved trails. With route modification, strollers/wheelchairs are okay. Rest rooms will be available on first part (3 blocks) of walk. An adult must accompany children 12 and under. Leashed pets are permitted. Location & Times: Registration is at Agnes Lamb Park, Meridian Ave. and Edwinola Way. Start walk between 8-9:30 a.m. Come early as the festival crowds have grown each year! Finish by 12:30 p.m. You do not have to register ahead of time. **Everyone is welcome!**


Directions: From I-75, take exit 285, Dade City/SR 52 (becomes Meridian Ave. in Dade City). Go EAST about 9 miles to 8th St. and turn left. Parking on right; park on left. From US 98/301 Bypass, WEST on Howard Ave. to 8th St. RIGHT on 8th St.; follow 8th St. as it curves left then right, crossing Meridian Ave. to Agnes Lamb Park. Parking is available on streets around park.



Fees: There is no formal "A" award and no preregistration. Walk only fee is \$2; walk with volkssport credit is \$3. Volkssporters track achievements in volkssport books. If interested in this incentive program, ask at registration for information. Kids 12 & under walk for free (no credit). **We can't make refunds for any reason; walk is held rain or shine.**

Special Programs: Today's walk is eligible for: America's Bakeries, Struttin Down Main Street, America's Historic Churches, and Honoring Law Enforcement.

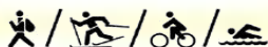
