Procedures for non-online start boxes: Ask for walk box at start location; please be considerate of staff and patrons. Register, sign waiver & use start cards to return at finish. You can earn volkssport event and distance credit every time you complete course. Insert pages, water and rest rooms are at start points. Pets are not permitted on Honeymoon Island seasonal route but are on other events (sometimes with alternate routes) if leashed, with exception of beaches on Tarpon Springs/Howard Park route. 
